

Improved M100T/M5000T Speed Switch to replace M100/M5000

Q: Do the new speed switches have the same setpoint range as the old ones?

A: Yes, the new M100T and M5000T Speed Switches cover the same setpoint ranges as before.

Q: Can I use the same Pulser Discs or Wraps that I currently have installed?

A: Yes, the new switches operate with the same Pulser Discs and Wraps as before.

Q: Are the new switches compatible with the EZ-100 Mounting Bracket assembly and Disc Guards?

A: Yes, the new switches work with the EZ-100 and stainless steel Disc Guards.

Q: Is the housing on the new switches XP, the same as the old M100/M5000?

A: Yes, the new switch housing is UL listed as both XP and NEMA 4X - a significant improvement.

Q: Is installation on the new switch as easy as on the old one?

A: It is now even easier. There is a terminal strip in the new M100T/M5000T for simplified wiring.

Q: Will the old M100 and M5000 be phased out and can I still get spares? What about price difference?

A: We have no plans to obsolete the old M100/M5000. However, the old M100/5000 models are more expensive to manufacture and will see a moderate price increase in 2012.
